# Office Of Research

---

- Part of Office of Executive Vice Chancellor for Research
- Basic goal of the Unit is to provide support for the research enterprise ranging from the contract and grants to obtaining permits and helping with intellectual property rights



## Cell Culture Facility (CCF)

---

- Is a centralized tissue culture, culture media production unit
- Also provides a spectrum of supplies on campus
- Located in S-1000, Genentech Hall and at Mission Center Building

# Office of Environmental Health and Safety (OEHS)

---

- Provides assistance and oversight of all hazardous materials and occupational safety related issues
- Radioactive materials, controlled substances registration
- Chemical waste disposal
- Training, ergonomics reviews, etc.

# Campus Intellectual Property Portfolio Management

---

- Assessing inventions as licensing opportunities
- Developing invention management strategies
- Securing intellectual property protection as needed
- Licensing campus technologies
- Forming new companies



# Important Points to Remember

---

- Disclose inventions when they are first in hand!
- Before writing the manuscript
- Well before the presentation
- This lead time is essential for the OTM to:
  - analyze the invention and determine its value as a business opportunity
  - Determine the competitive advantage it might afford a licensee
  - Waiting until the 11th hour creates problems for inventors and the OTM.

# Animal Housing Needs

---

- If you need animal housing; please send an e-mail describing your requested space (e.g. 100 cages of rodents), a brief justification and time-frame needed
- All requests are reviewed and approved by the Animal Users Advisory Committee (Chair, Dr. Anthony DeFranco)



# Office of Sponsored Research

---

- There is a separate presentation by the unit



# Institutional Animal Care and Use Committees (IACUC)

---

- IACUC reviews and approves all protocols involving the use of animals
- Submit a protocol at least 4-6 weeks before intended start date
- Remember that IACUC approval does not guarantee housing space!
- Mission Bay there is additional space



# Committee on Human Research (CHR)

---

- Committee on Human Research (CHR), reviews and approves all protocols involving human subjects and identifiable human tissue
- Submit a protocol at least 8-10 weeks before intended start date
- The CHR review has been slow due to increases in submittals
- There are three faculty Committees that review applications



# Committee on Human Research (CHR)

---

- CHR has specific training requirements
- The training is web based

# Technical Committees

---

- Radiation Safety Committee (RSC) reviews and approves all radioactive materials use
- Biosafety Committee (BSC) reviews and approves all biological materials
- *There are two other Committees: Chemical Safety, and, Radioactive Drug Research.*
- *Committees meet monthly and approval typically is by the meeting following your submittal*
