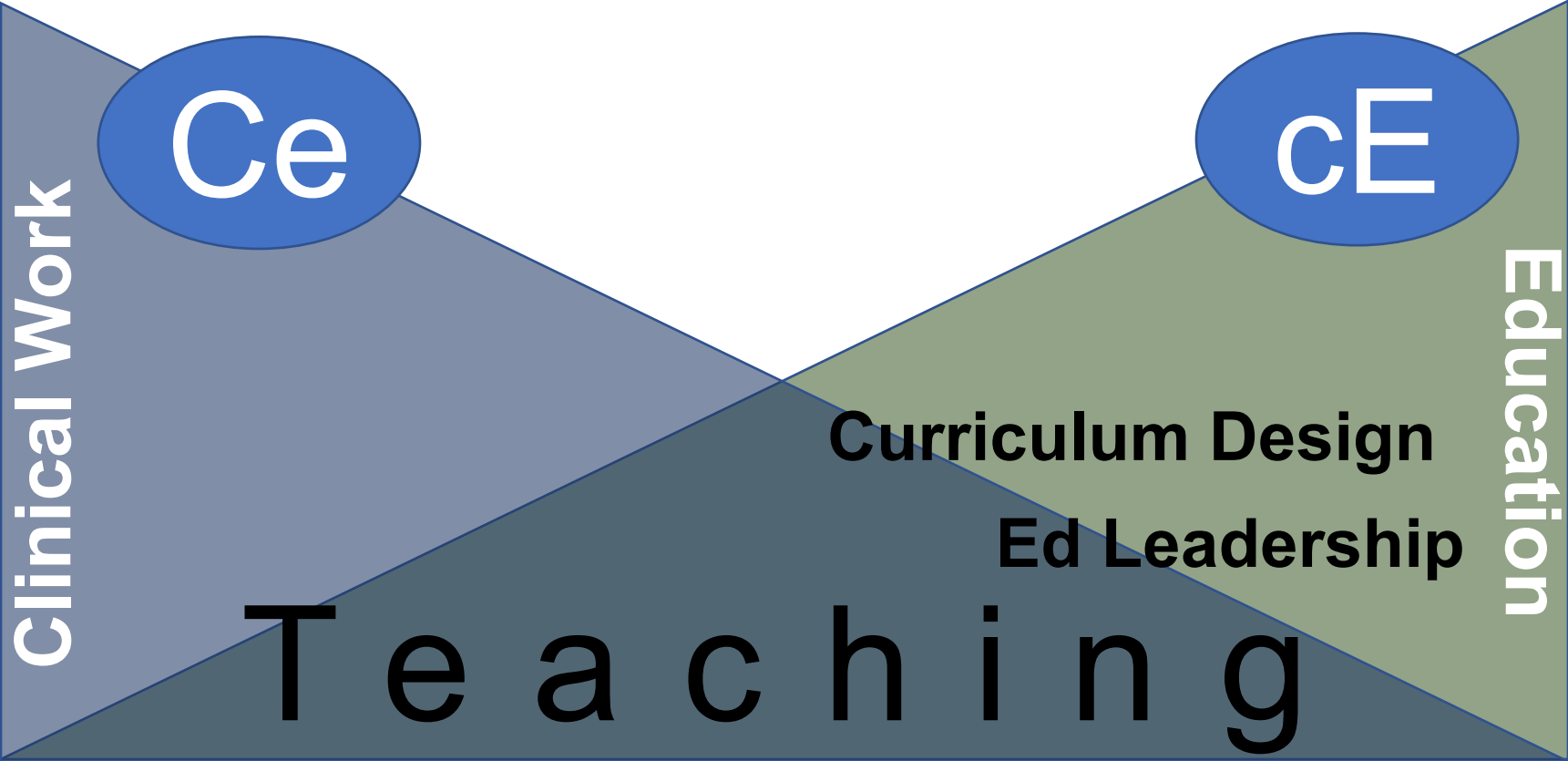

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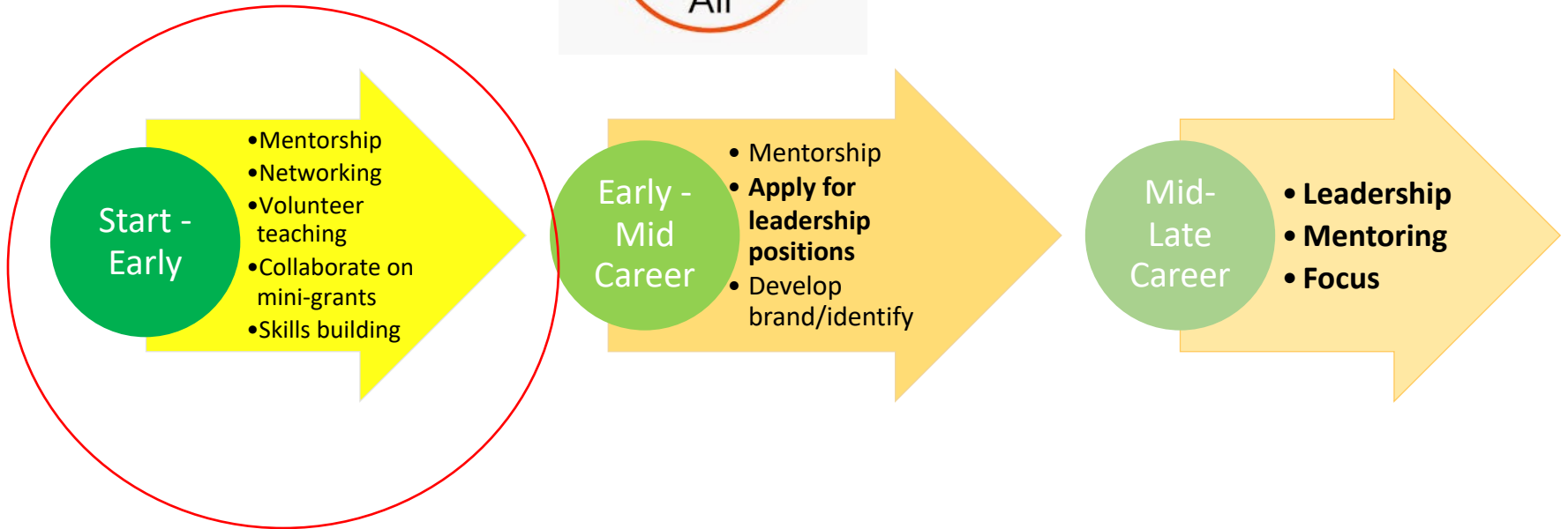

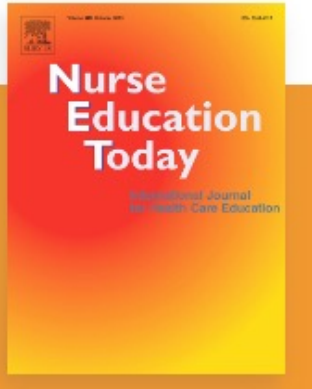

- Designing your evaluations to be publishable can increase the perceived 'value' of your education work
- Consider:
 - UCSF Education Showcase
 - Academic conference posters
 - Manuscript publication
 - MedEd Portal (open access)
 - Profession specific journals on education

The Program for Interprofessional Practice and Education (PIPE) **Interprofessional Clinical Opportunities Grant** supports clinical sites in piloting new interprofessional immersive experiences for learners (students, residents and/or fellows) in the health professional programs at UCSF. Grantees receive **\$10,000** to design and implement their experience. PIPE provides consultation and support for faculty interested in applying for funding.

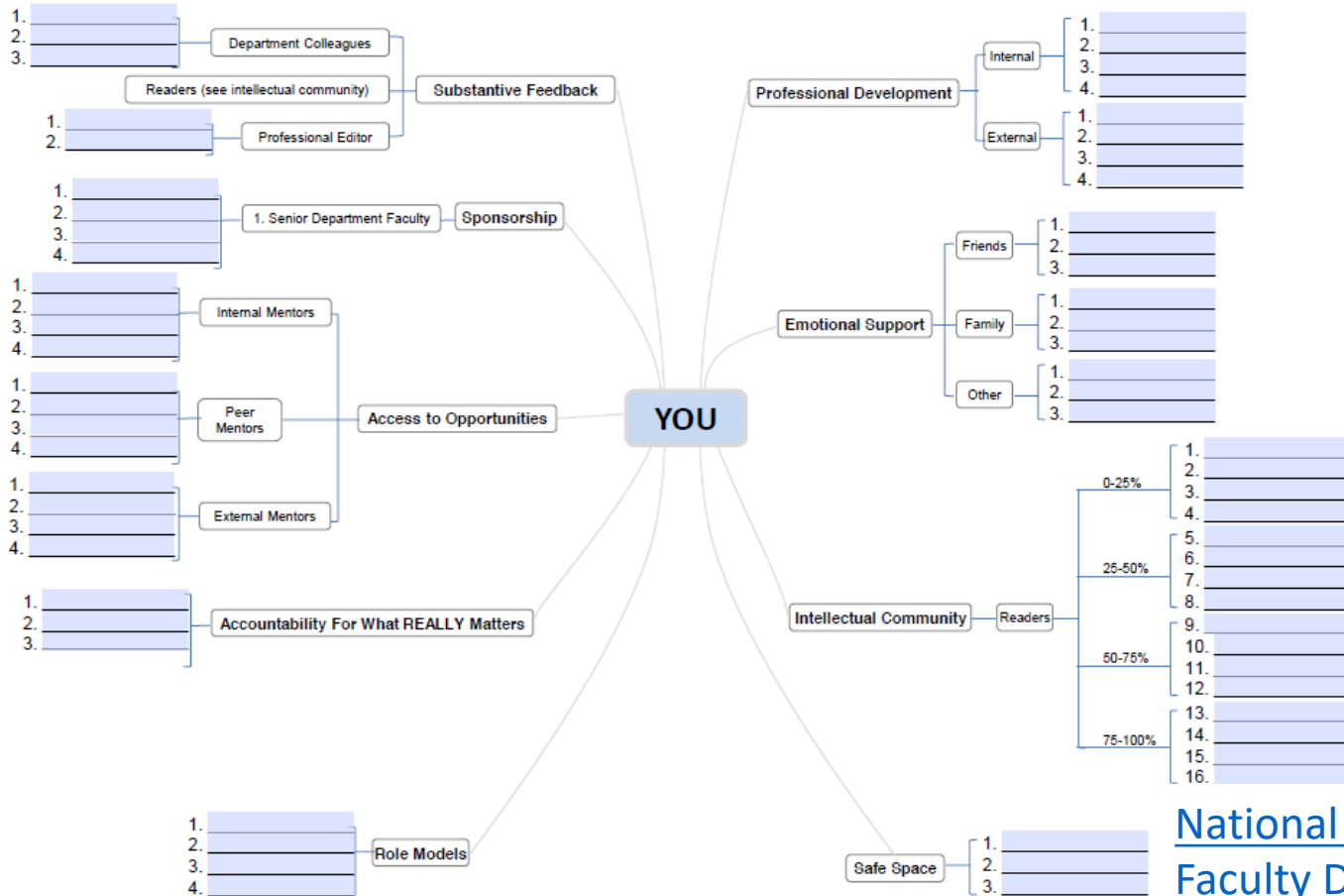

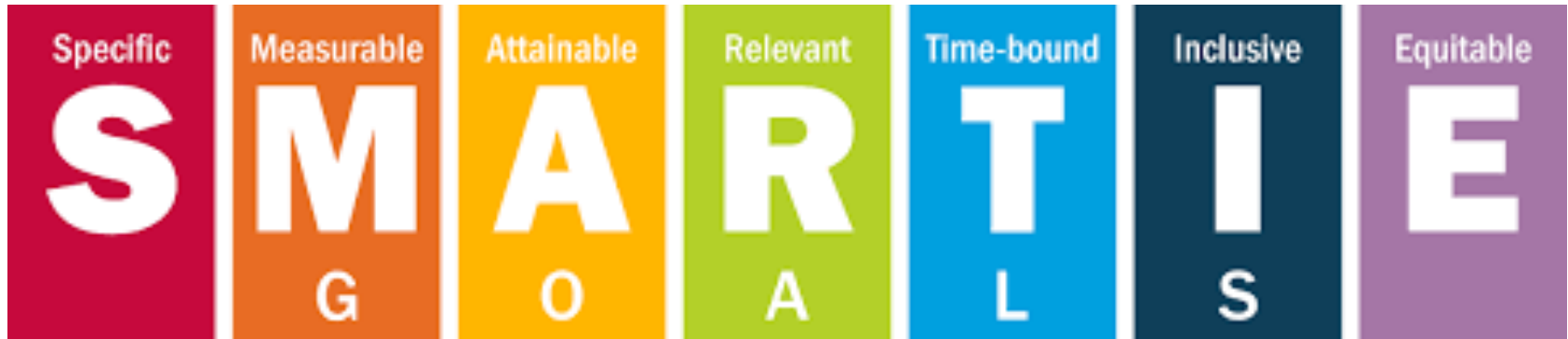
